# Introduction

Welcome to the new, enlarged 2007 Graham Farish (GF) catalogue. For the past 36 years we have consistently produced an ever-increasing range of high quality UK N scale products that encompasses model railway locomotives, rolling stock, controls and accessories. Proving that we do listen to customer requests and to help new enthusiasts enjoy this fascinating hobby we have now added extra information, with an Era of operation number for each model. This enables models to be quickly identified for a specific modelling period e.g. British Railways (BR) Blue livery from the 1970's, which are Era's 6/7. (see the ERA description table)

We are constantly striving to improve the quality and range of Graham Farish models and this year we will release our first Digital Command control (DCC) ready steam locomotive. This model establishes another GF milestone, with a ground breaking first for the UK N Gauge market. The Jubilee 4-6-0 will have see through spoked wheels. DCC is now added to all new models, where it is practical to do so, meeting the needs of the modern enthusiast.

2007 will see at least eight Graham Farish model locomotives made DCC ready and to complement these we are now launching our second generation of EZ Command Digital Controller. Dynamis provides the user with a simple, cost effective solution to all Digital Command control needs and is a fully compliant NMRA system utilising the latest technology. Typical of our passion for innovation we have once again risen to the challenge. Dynamis is a wireless system, which allows the user to move around without being tied to a fixed point.

Brand new Graham Farish models for 2007 include two new steam locomotives. The first is the powerful BR 9F 2-10-0 including a model of the famous 'Evening Star'. The second is the much requested Ivatt 2MT 2-6-0 tender locomotive. For the BR diesel enthusiast there is a Class 37/0 diesel with options for split and centre head code options in BR Blue and Green liveries.

Our modern, privatised railway range continues to develop with the introduction of the latest variant of Class 66/9 locomotive. The actual locomotives have been designed as environmentally friendly as possible by reducing exhaust emissions to a minimum. Our Graham Farish 66/9 model will be available in several liveries including that of famous hauler Eddie Stobart. For modern passenger trains we are introducing Class 220/222 Diesel Multiple Units (DMU) These are four car units in three liveries that can also run in multiples or with a Class 57 rescue locomotive.


New wagons include a 3 Plank wagon, Conflats with a variety of Container styles both large and small and a 20 Ton LMS Brake Van. The Brake Van was first produced before the 2nd World War with the last few surviving up to post privatisation. There are two new modern freight wagons, a twin Intermodal Bogie wagon with a variety of 45' Containers and a JGA bogie hopper wagon in three liveries.

These will all be brand new products and are designed for the 21st Century, containing all the features you would expect from a modern Graham Farish model.

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The Bachmann Collectors' Club continues to expand and now has over 6000 members. This quality quarterly magazine contains all the news on Bachmann products in every scale, feature articles and reader offers. Where space permits on items such as the new Jubilee and Voyager models, these will be supplied with 6 pin sockets to take NEM type 651 small Decoders. The user removes the DC blanking plug and replaces this with a suitable 6-pin Decoder of their choice.

# Modern Image

With the formation of British Railways in 1948, engineers quickly started to design and build diesel locomotives with the long-term aim of replacing steam traction. A variety of types soon started to appear in the early 1950's eventually establishing classic designs such as the 04 Diesel Shunter, the Class 20 Bo-Bo Diesel and the universal Class 47 Co-Co Diesel Locomotive.

Passenger Diesel Multiple Units (DMU's) also began to appear and evolved into High Speed Train fleets during the 1970's. A new breed of modern DMU's, such as the Class 170 are now an everyday scene. 2007 sees the fleet of Graham Farish DMU's expanded even further with the introduction of Class 220 and 222 Virgin and Bombardier DMU designs.

Graham Farish capture all of this, plus more, with the UK's largest range of Diesel and Electric model locomotives. Powerful and reliable models are available in BR and current post privatisation liveries such as Virgin and Chiltern Trains. The range includes super detailed models that start with the 'Peak' family of Class 44, 45 and 46 designs plus Classes 04, 57, 60 and 66 (the 66 is the UK's first DCC-ready model in the UK) and are now joined by the Class 37 and the new low emissions Class 66/9 locomotives.

# Steam Locomotives

Modern Railways started because of small powerful tank locomotives the development of the steam locomotive, which rapidly evolved into a diverse range of prototypes with designs reaching a zenith in the 1930's and finally ending in 1968 when steam was replaced by cleaner and cheaper to use Diesel and Electric motive power.

Graham Farish captures this by-gone age, with a broad range of model steam locomotives. The range covers the big four (1923) railway companies plus BR designs, from

such as the LMS Jinty or the GWR Pannier tank locomotive, to sleek and fast express locomotives such as the famous Flying Scotsman. The models are available in a wide range of liveries including pristine and weathered finishes. The range has now been complimented by new super detailed models, starting with the LNER V2, the LMS Jubilee and are now joined by the British Rail (BR) designed 2-10-0 9F's and Ivatts 2-6-0 tender locomotives.

## WESTERN









Of the four railway companies which were formed on 1st January 1923 the Great Western was unique. It was the only company to absorb others, to retain its own territories intact, and to keep its original identity.

GWR absorbed thirty-two smaller railway companies including nearly all the Welsh railways and the network of railway owned docks in South Wales. It extended from London west and north-west as far as Birmingham and the South Midlands. To the south and west, the new

company covered most of Devon and all Cornwall, sharing the other counties with the Southern Railway.

The Great Western was famed for its prestigious trains serving Bristol, South Wales, Devon and Cornwall. Trains such as the 'Cheltenham Flyer' and 'Cornish Riviera Limited' were household names.

One of the main features of the Great Western Railway was that it was very individual and proud to be so. From the 1830s right through to nationalisation It was known by

people, according to their loyalties, as either 'God's Wonderful Railway' or the 'Great Way Round'. It was typical of the company that even during nationalisation it could still be thought that there were five regions of British Railways and the Great Western!

Our GWR range this year includes locomotives covering all operations from mainline working to shunting, plus a comprehensive range of coaches and wagons.



At the grouping of the railway companies in 1923, the London Midland and Scottish Railway became largest of the big four railway companies inherited nearly 10,500 locomotives from the seven smaller companies which combined to form the LMS.

The territory covered by the LMS track and a main line from London to

Bristol in the south west across to Southend-on Sea in the south east, and up to Thurso and Wick in the north of Scotland. It also linked Belfast with Larne and Londonderry in Northern Ireland.

At the time of the grouping, the LMS had a total of 19,000 miles of single extended from South Wales and Wick 729 miles in length. The

company operated in thirty-two of the forty English counties and until 1939 had a staff bigger than the entire British Army! At the height of its prosperity, the London Midland & Scottish Railway was the largest joint stock corporation in the world.



The London & North Eastern Railway seven main companies which made companies which had become had its roots with George Stephenson and the world's first public railway. One of the companies which became part of LNER was the North Eastern Railway Company which evolved from the Stockton and Darlington Railway founded in 1825.

After the grouping in 1923, the LNER was second in size only to the LMS and inherited an extremely varied collection of locomotives from the up the LNER.

From the Great Eastern Railway, the newly formed LNER also inherited the most intensive suburban service in the world and from the North Eastern and Great Central, a very busy coal and mineral system.

When the LNER was created, it formalised the long-standing alliance between the three major member

known as the East Coast route, providing a fast service from London to Edinburgh. The territory covered by the LNER included the whole of the eastern side of the country north of London, right up to Lossiemouth in Scotland and across the country to Liverpool, Chester, Wrexham, Stafford, Penrith and Carlisle, There was also a very long and tortuous line across to Mallaig giving access to the Scottish Western Isles.





The Southern Railway was the smallest of the 'Big Four' railway companies formed in the 1923 grouping of Britain's railway system. Although the smallest, it was in many wavs one of the most interestina.

It was formed from three principal railway companies all of which were of similar size and standing. Namely 'The London Brighton and South Coast', 'The South Eastern and Chatham' and the marginally larger 'London and South Western Railway'. The new Southern was able to easily


take the very best ideas from all three companies without a great deal of political pressure from a dominant constituent.

It was unique in that it introduced an extensive electrification plan for suburban services. The London network of electric commuter lines was far more complicated than any of the three systems. This resulted in Steam power basically being confined to non-electrified lines or routes. Steam power was not the foremost prime mover as in other

companies such as the LMS. There was not the need to continually develop new Steam Locomotives. This resulted in older steam locomotives being retained until they were simply replaced by electric

The Southern Railway was also the only one of the 'Bia Four' railway companies to gain the majority of its revenue from passenger traffic as opposed to freight.



## BR STANDARD



After the Second World War the railways faced a massive increase in passenger traffic, especially in the suburbs and during holiday periods. An immediate programme of replacement locomotives and new developments was put in hand by all four companies. But nationalisation interrupted their plans and the Transport Bill was issued on 28th November 1946. British Railways came into effect at midnight on 31st December 1947. From this date the four big companies - LMS, LNER, GWR and SR-became one.

The four main groups were replaced by six new regions- London Midland, Western, Southern, Eastern, North Eastern, and Scottish- each of which was given a distinctive colour for use on signs and in publicity.

After nationalisation, twelve fully standardised locomotives were designed which could be used throughout the country. By 1960 British Rail had built 999 of these standard locomotives as well as 1,538 engines of pre-nationalisation design. Steam locomotives began to disappear in the early 1960's and

were finally replaced completely by diesel and electric locomotives by 1968.

However many steam locomotives can still be seen at the National Railway Museum in York and at the many privately owned lines around the country.

The British Railways steam locomotives in our range include examples from most regions, in a variety of BR liveries. They are complimented by a wide range of coaches and wagons.
